HBRC members can list (voluntarily) on the annual club registration form any pre-existing medical conditions and medications taken. These conditions and medications will only be shared with the HBRC committee and run leaders on a needs basis as per the clubs privacy policy.

## **Incident reporting**

In the case of a medical incident or near miss at a HBRC event or training an incident report is to be filed by the attending First Aid Officer, Run Leader or Race Director. The incident report will be addressed by the administration sub-committee and reported to HBRC committee.

#### **Closest Points for Ambulance Access for Club Events**

An event Course Safety Marshall or First Aid Officer can phone the ambulance from the *Emergency + App* so a GPS location is relayed direct to the Ambulance service. Refer below for a descriptive location if the above App is not used.

## Monthly Handicap at Greenwich Reserve:

If the emergency incident is at the Start/Finish location, refer to the driveway to the Warmies Boat Ramp approximately 200m east of the North Road/The Strand intersection.

If an emergency incident occurs on the running course please quote the nearest intersecting street with The Strand.

# **Events held at Newport Park Athletics Track**

The entrance to the athletic track car park is approximately 100m east then a further 100m north from the North Road/The Strand, Newport road intersection. Then turn left onto the gravel driveway that leads direct to the athletic track carpark.

# **Events held at Newport Lakes**

Entrance to the Newport Lakes car-park is via Lakes Drive off the North Side of Mason Street, Newport.

If incident occurs remotely away from the carpark area quote the road intersection nearest to the closest park entrance pedestrian gate.
